The extended abstract must be written in English using Times New Roman font. The body of the extended abstract should not exceed 1000 words.

Each abstract must include the full name and complete address of all author(s). In the case of joint authorship, the name of the author who will actually present the paper should be indicated with an asterisk (*).

Abstracts will only be accepted on the understanding that the work will be presented in person.
